# About the brewery

The story of the Malka Brewery began in 2006, bourn from the love of nature and a desire to further beer culture in Israel. Assaf Lavi, who was the owner of two pubs in Tel Aviv, left the Big City and moved to the ecological community of Klil and began brewing beer in small batches.

Assaf chose the name “Malka” (Queen, in Hebrew) because the word “beer” in Hebrew is feminine and he wanted the name to reflect both royal connotations as well as something for the masses. After the recipes were formulated, Assaf loaded his pickup with Malka Pale Ale, Malka Blond Ale and Malka Stout and began distributing the beers in Tel Aviv.

In 2008 the brewery was established in Kibbutz Yechi’am, at the foot of the fortress, in the Galilee, facing the sea. Since then, the brewery produces ales in a traditional manner and in small batches. The process begins by using the finest base products and it involves uncompromising quality control.

In 2018 we have upgraded our operation and moved to the nearby industrial zone of TEFEN, where we have implemented state of the art brewing and packaging technologies to even better our special products.

Today we are leading the Israeli Craft Beer Market producing over 1,000,000 liters of beer annually

# Malka Blond Ale 6.5%

This is a Belgian-style ale, inspired by seasonal Saison recipes. This ale is characterized by notes of citrus, as a result of the addition of orange peels and coriander seeds to the brewing process, and the use of special hops.



# Malka Pale Ale 5.5%

A classic British Pale ale type characterized by a bready taste of barley and deep reddish hue. This beer is brewed with large quantities of hops which impart a certain bitterness but does not overpower the distinct malt tastes.





# Malka Dry Stout 6%

An Irish-style dry stout, characterized by a roasted taste with notes of bitter chocolate and coffee, and possessing a soft, velvety mouth-feel. Its dark hue is due to the use of malt that underwent an intense and long roast at high temperatures.



# Malka Hoppy Wheat 5%

An American style wheat beer characterized by a golden hue and cloudiness, great head retention and hoppy aroma that comes from dry-hopping.



# Malka IPA 6.2%

An IPA characterized by a deep copper hue and caramel taste that come along citrus aroma and bitter finish.
